based on Matthew 9:14-17



Idea #1

Dance with scarves or ribbons on sticks.
(The scarves represent cloth).

Idea #2

Try writing a couplet poem (2 lines, it rhymes, one thought)

Example:

That comfortable old pair of pants
Needs an old patch or it'll split when you dance.



Idea #3

The focus of this art activity is to think about how you live your life. Think about how the teachings of Jesus come alive for you.

Instructions:

Get some kind of a physical container. It can be really simple like a small box or a paper cup. If you want to create a project that takes more time you can get a more permanent object like a nice box, a clay pot, etc.

The container represents the wineskin in the parable. The container holds your beliefs and actions that are inspired by the principles Jesus has taught us. Put inside your container things that represent these principles of how you live your life. They can be small physical objects, or you can put in images and phrases on paper. You can make small mini drawings on a note card sized paper in either abstract designs or more realistic images. Or you can write down phrases of how you incorporate Jesus' teachings into your life.

Decorate the outside of your "wineskin" too. The container represents yourself so decorate it in a way that reflects your beauty and strength and kindness and all the other good qualities that define you.
